

Two one-month fellowships in France

The Institute of Atomic Physics (IFA), the Horia Hulubei National Institute of Physics and Nuclear Engineering (IFIN-HH), the National Institute for Laser, Plasma and Radiation Physics (INFLPR), the National Institute of Materials Physics (INFIM), the National Institute for Optoelectronics (INOE) and the National Institute for Earth Physics (INFP), with the support of the French Embassy in Romania, offer two one-month fellowships to young Romanian researchers (born in 1978 or later) who want to improve their collaboration with their French counterparts.

The fellowships will be given to candidates that hold a PhD in a field of Physics and work in one of the five National Research Institutes (IFIN-HH, INFLPR, INFIM, INOE, INFP) with a French partner (laboratory, research institute, university) on different research projects.

The period covered by the fellowship is one-month (31 days maximum). The fellowships are given for 2013*.

The two selected candidates will receive 1750 EUR to cover their expenses. During their stay in France the candidates will receive the Social Security.

The candidates have to submit their application folder, in a closed envelope, **until the 16th of September** to the IFA Secretariat (IFA building, 8th floor, room 809).

The candidates must also confirm their application by sending an email, with their Curriculum Vitae enclosed to the message, to Mr. Bertrand DE BOISDEFFRE and Mrs. Justine LACOUSSE (French Embassy in Bucharest / bertrand.boisdeffre@institutfrancais-roumanie.com; Justine.lacousse@diplomatie.gouv.fr).

Application folder:

- Copy of the PhD diploma
- Curriculum Vitae with the list of publications
- Abstract of the PhD
- Research project and details of the work which will be done during the fellowship
- Letter of acceptance from the French partner for the period covered by the fellowship and for the work plan
- Letter of recommendation from the home institute/laboratory

The selection of the candidates will follow a two-step evaluation procedure: 1) a pre-selection of candidates based on the application folder; 2) an interview with the pre-selected candidates.

* The candidates who want to spend one month in France must start their residence prior to the 1st December 2013.
