Achievements and prospects of Romania's participation in CERN experiments

Romanian teams participating in ALICE, ATLAS, LHCb, WLCG, ISOLDE, n_TOF and NA62 experiments at CERN will present the main results obtained in the last year and the perspectives on future collaboration within the projects coordinated by IFIN-HH and ISS and financed by ANCSI – IFA under the Romania-CERN Programme. Two new proposals for participating in MoEDAL and WA105 experiments as well as a new initiative regarding the outreach in particle physics will also be presented. The symposium will be held on the occasion of the annual meeting of the International Scientific Advisory Board (ISAB), the body that performs the evaluation and monitoring of the research projects ensuring Romania's participation in CERN experiments.
