I have also up loaded on CIRCA, in your Association steering Committee folder under IPR, a scanned document also detailing all the requirements for technology transfer and what should be included in the various license agreements. I am afraid it is very large, hence the use of CIRCA.

After discussion with my colleagues I think that this is a bit ambitious as all license agreements need to be tailored to the individual case. If in the future your association requires a license agreement we are of course at your disposal in support in its drafting.
